Professional development and training at IWC Medical Centre

IWC is committed to delivery of quality, affordable holistic care for people across our communities.

As part of this commitment, IWC offers training and professional development pathways within our General Practice for:

- **All IWC GPs:** As part of ongoing professional development, on occasion a Senior Doctor may observe (sit in on) a consultation. This is a method of sharing discussion over aspects of General Practice delivery.
- **Registrars:** These Junior Doctors are advancing toward being a General Practitioner. They work under supervision in IWC Medical Practice.
- **Overseas Trained Doctors:** IWC is an Approved Sponsor for Overseas Trained Doctors seeking to relocate to Australia. The GPs joining us from overseas are fully trained and highly experienced, but are required to undertake further accreditation / validation in Australia. IWC has Supervisor GPs to support this.
- **Medical Students:** Trainee doctors are invited to the IWC Medical Centre where they are able to observe and learn from experienced professionals.



As the IWC Medical Director, I lead a team of Supervisor GPs. I oversee all training and professional development of GPs, Registrars and Trainee Doctors.

What this means for you

As a patient of this General Practice, you may on occasion have two medical personnel involved in your consultation, one of whom may be supervising or observing only.

This is part of the way IWC is supporting our Medical Centre's capacity to serve our community through building the number of GPs available in our regions.

We also are proud to be able to offer a highly professional frontline learning environment for the next generation of GPs.
